- The exhibits should be designed keeping in mind parameters such as **creativity, originality, scientific approach, technical skills, educational value, utility, cost-effectiveness, portability, and durability**.
- Students may work on their ideas during the summer break and submit their projects to their Science or Mathematics teachers once the school reopens.

- Once the school reopens, students may consult their respective teachers for guidance and suggestions to further refine their ideas and presentations.
- Students are encouraged to explore, innovate, and develop solutions that showcase the practical applications of Science and Mathematics in everyday life.
